

Roll - A - Tone

A Game for Practicing Tone of Voice

Objective: Students will improve their understanding that the tone of their voice and their use of inflection can convey different meanings regardless of the words they are using.



















- Roll a tone worksheet
- 3 Dice

Directions:

1. Pick one student to be the speaker and up to three students to roll the dice. If more than 1 student is rolling the dice, determine an order for rolling.
2. The first person rolls the dice to determine the sentence the speaker will use.
3. The second person rolls the dice to determine which word the speaker will emphasize.
4. The third person rolls the dice to determine what tone of the voice the speaker will use.
5. Once all dice have been rolled the speaker tries out the sentence use the selected word to emphasize and the selected tone.
6. At this point, the whole group can try saying the whole sentence as the speaker said it.
7. Finish by having the students use a calm/happy voice to repeat the sentence.
