Roll - A - Tone A Game for Practicing Tone of Voice

<u>Objective</u>: Students will improve their understanding that the tone of their voice and their use of inflection can convey different meanings regardless of the words they are using.

<u>Materials Needed:</u>

- Roll a tone worksheet
- 3 Dice

Directions:

- 1. Pick one student to be the speaker and up to three students to roll the dice. If more than 1 student is rolling the dice, determine an order for rolling.
- 2. The first person rolls the dice to determine the sentence the speaker will use.
- 3. The second person rolls the dice to determine which word the speaker will emphasize.
- 4. The third person rolls the dice to determine what tone of the voice the speaker will use.
- 5. Once all dice have been rolled the speaker tries out the sentence use the selected word to emphasize and the selected tone.
- 6. At this point, the whole group can try saying the whole sentence as the speaker said it.
- 7. Finish by having the students use a calm/happy voice to repeat the sentence.
